## Proposed native/deciduous azalea selections for a Fall 2021 azalea sale at Dothan Area Botanical Gardens



This azalea was first collected in the 1960s just below the Woodruff Dam. Its fragrant, bright yellow-gold flowers are born in trusses that can light up the edges of a woodland garden.
